<p><b>Everyday words</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• List high-use, everyday words that relate to your content and context.</li> <li>• You can include some less common words as long as they don't belong in the lists below.</li> <li>• ESOL tip: consider words from the second thousand (2K) word list.</li> </ul>	<p>Step 3</p>
<p><b>Academic words</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• List academic words you need for your content and context.</li> <li>• Think of words that describe processes or academic tasks.</li> <li>• You can include some high-use specialised words.</li> <li>• ESOL tip: consider words from the academic word list (AWL).</li> <li>• Highly specialised or technical words should be in the list below.</li> </ul>	<p>Step 4/5</p>
<p><b>Technical words</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• List the more highly specialised and technical words you need for your content and context.</li> <li>• Think of the jargon of your trade or content area including specialised acronyms and informal language.</li> <li>• ESOL tip: You can include words outside of the 1K, 2K, and AWL.</li> </ul>	<p>Step 6</p>
